PANDORA'S BOX

- 1  **Once upon a time**, there were two brothers, Prometheus  and

- 4 gods, got angry with them  because fire  was only for the gods. So he

- 7 Zeus  sent for Epimetheus . “Here is a wife  for you, Epimetheus,” he said.

- 10 must never open it .” Epimetheus and Pandora were soon married . He put
